

Health & Safety considerations for a visit to Pannett Park

Supervision

Children should be supervised at all times

Consideration of others

Please be considerate towards other users of the park

Don't block pathways

No skate boards, scooters, bicycles

No ball games

Weather conditions

Particular attention to be paid to extreme or inclement weather

Be aware of -

Falling tree branches in high winds

Slippery paths in heavy rain, frost or snow

Respect the flora & fauna

Don't pick the flowers or walk among plants to cause damage

Remember some plants may be poisonous or cause allergic reactions

Don't approach or disturb the wildlife

Group leaders/supervisors

It is useful if they can be clearly identified

Surfaces

Care needs to be taken on steps, steep slopes & uneven surfaces

In particular some of the grassy banks are very steep & not suitable to walk on

Water hazard

Take particular care in the area of the Lily Pool

No paddling

Photography

Permission needs to be asked of parents/guardians to use photos of children

First aid

Do you have trained first aiders?

Safety of bags

Remember to keep bags within sight & be aware that seagulls will raid picnics
