

Out and about...
A walk through the park

- Leave the Museum by main door. Go down the steps to the octagon, turn left onto the path leading out of the park. At the gates, turn right along St. Hilda's Terrace until you see the sign for Little Park. Go through the gap in the wall into the South Seas Garden.
- Pass 3 benches, turn right and go down 8 steps at the edge of the park. Keep to the middle path. How many turtles can you see? Leave the South Seas Garden and walk down the path with the Rockery on your right and re-enter Pannett Park.
- Turn left, go down 3 steps and follow the path to the T junction. Turn left and walk along until you see some steps on your left leading down to the Lily Pool. Walk down to look at the Lily Pool. TAKE CARE! Which family gave the Pool to Whitby?
- Now turn right and walk up the path. Go through the wooden arches (pergola) then take the lower path to the corner of the park. Look carefully at the trees. What can you see high up in the branches? Continue as far as the Monkey Puzzle Tree and become a Time Traveller, going back to Jurassic Times. (Don't disturb the crocodile!).

At the end of the Upper Jurassic go straight ahead to leave the park on Chubb Hill. Watch out for 21st Century travellers!

- Turn right up Chubb Hill and walk along the Whitby Timeline. Don't be late! What time is it now?

 Come back into the park through the next opening. Walk up the path, turning left and then right towards the building. Look for another pergola and walk through it. What famous Whitby building can you see in the distance?
- Turn right, go down 5 steps and turn left. Look carefully. Can you see the Stone Circle? How many stones are there?
- Walk through the circle and head towards the rockery. Follow the path round into the Commemorative Garden. Take time to read the words on the wall. Look through the wooden arches. What can you see?



Climb up 9 steps and then up the central steps which lead to the Pannett Art Gallery & Whitby Museum. Stand in the octagon, turn right and then as you leave the terrace turn left. You should come to the Play Area. Look for 6 palm trees and there you will find the Treasure Chest!

There is no treasure left in this chest but you will find lots of treasures in Whitby Museum!
